THEMSELVES**” CHURCH

•

“You are **neither hot nor cold...**” (15b).

“...because **you are lukewarm**, I will
spew you out of my mouth” (16).

“For you say, ‘I am *rich*, and have
prospered, and I *need nothing*;
not realizing that you are *wretched*,
pitiabile, poor, blind, and naked” (17).

“...buy from me **gold refined by fire**,
so that you may be rich...” (18a).

“...and **white garments** so that...the shame
of your nakedness may not be seen” (18b).

“...and **salve to anoint your eyes**,
that you may see” (18c).

“...**be zealous** and **repent**” (19b).

ζήλευε (“*be zealous*”)—Present Tense
Have **constant, continuous, undying zeal.**

“Those *whom I **love*** I reprove and chasten...” (19a).

“Behold, **I stand at the door and knock**. If anyone *hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him...*” (20).

κρούω (“knock”)—*Present Tense*
The Lord is **continuously knocking** at *your* door.

“The one who *conquers, I will grant him to sit with me on my throne, as I also conquered and sat down with my Father* on his throne” (21).
