# IS IT, OR ISN'T IT?

In logic, the Law of Excluded Middle states that every single thing either *is*, or it *is not*.

For ex., there either *is milk* in your refrigerator, or there *is not milk* in your refrigerator.

Or, the milk that is in your refrigerator either *is spoiled*, or the milk *is not spoiled*.

In both of these examples, there is *no middle ground*—i.e., **no third option**.

# HOW TO PROVE GOD EXISTS

SOME "HONORABLE MENTIONS"

## LAW REQUIRES A LAWMAKER.

If there is a single law of nature present in the universe (and there are several), there *must* be **someone who put that law in place.**

## CODE REQUIRES A CODER.

*Per* scientists own reasoning (re: aliens in outer space), the *DNA code* is solid **proof of intelligent design/divine creation.**

## COMMUNICATION REQUIRES A COMMUNICATOR.

Man's *exclusive* ability to speak (intelligibly), write, and read is evidence that **Someone gave him that ability.**
